

II. Facing Your Obstacles to Taking Action

Three obstacles to action in disciple-making that must be addressed to see progress.



Is This Your Story? ••

As a believer, one of the most important tasks we are entrusted with is to make disciples and start churches in the community. Jesus calls all of His followers in the Great Commission found in Matthew 28:18-20 to teach others to obey all He has commanded and modeled.

However, many believers may struggle with taking action on this task due to various challenges and obstacles.

In this section, we will discuss the top obstacles that Christian believers may face when trying to make disciples or start churches in their community.



Obstacle 1: Lack of Abiding that Leads to a Lifestyle of Obedience

One of the biggest obstacles that many Christian believers face is a lack of abiding in Christ that leads to a lifestyle of obedience.

Abiding in Christ means having a close, personal relationship with Him and allowing His teachings to influence every aspect of our lives. Without this close relationship with Christ, it can be difficult to follow His command to make disciples and start churches.

THIS Defines Those That Multiply

Believers who do not abide in Christ may struggle with obedience to His teachings. This can block their ability to effectively make disciples and start churches in their community.

Therefore, it is essential for Christian believers to prioritize a fully surrendered and obedient relationship with Christ, and to continually seek His guidance and wisdom.



Obstacle 2: Lack of Answers to Key Questions

Another obstacle that many Christian believers face is a lack of answers to key questions regarding disciplemaking and church planting. We often get stuck either in understanding "how" or in believing we are qualified.

The four main questions we need effective skill development in include:

- Why should we make disciples?
- Who should we disciple?
- What should we say to get started?
- When should we take action?

You Need Answers.

Without clear answers to these questions, it can be difficult for believers to feel confident in their ability or even actually be committed to make disciples and start churches. Therefore, it is important for Christian believers to get answers to these questions through training from other experienced disciple makers that are a few steps ahead.

Obstacle 3: Lack of a Clear Process and Big Vision

The third obstacle to action that many Christian believers face is a lack of a clear process and big picture strategy for disciple-making and church planting that comes from the Bible.

Without a clear understanding of the steps involved in the process, it can be difficult for believers to know where to start and how to move forward.

This is where the 4 Fields Framework and process comes in.

These strategies provide a clear process and big picture strategy for disciplemaking and church planting that is based on the Bible.

In the next section, we will discuss these strategies in more detail and provide examples of how they have been used effectively in the past.


A Biblical Strategy

The Four Fields of Kingdom Growth process and vision for multiplication is rooted in the strategy of Jesus.

The parts of the process can actually be seen modeled in the Gospels and then reproduced in turn by the apostles in the book of Acts.


What's the point?

In short, the Four Fields is not an idea or man-made strategy, but rather a Biblical process for making disciples and starting churches.



The Four Fields / Five Parts

- 1. **Empty Field (Entry):** The first step is identifying a new field where there are no believers and no knowledge of God. This represents entering a new area or community where the gospel has not yet been shared.
- 2. Sowing the Seed (Gospel Sharing): After entering the field, the next step is to sow the seed, which in the Kingdom of God represents sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with those who have not yet heard it.
- 3. Watering the Seed (Discipleship): Once the gospel has been shared, the seed needs to be nurtured and cared for, symbolized by watering the seed. This represents the process of biblical discipleship, helping new believers grow in their faith.
- 4. **Growing and Harvesting (Church Formation):** As the seed grows and matures, the next step is harvesting, which in the Kingdom of God is forming these new disciples into a church. This also includes developing leaders within the church.
- 5. **Reproducing (Multiplication):** Finally, the process repeats itself. The new church plants more churches, and the cycle of entering new fields, sowing the gospel, nurturing disciples, and forming churches continues, leading to a multiplying movement.



The Impact of Four Fields

By implementing the 4 Fields / 5 Parts of Kingdom Growth, believers can effectively reach their community with the gospel and start multiplying churches.

This Kingdom process has been successfully used in various contexts.

These include the United States, Asia, Africa, South America, urban and rural, literate and illiterate, and more.

How do I know it will work for me?

In short — it's Biblical.

It is about us realigning with a Biblical model that anyone can follow, regardless of their location, culture, social status, or education.

At this point, you may be asking: "How do I get started?" This checklist sets you up for success.



Checklist for Prayer and Fasting:

- Set aside time each day to pray for the people you are reaching (by name if at all possible).
- Fast regularly to seek God's guidance and power.
- Pray for specific needs and opportunities.
- Keep a prayer journal to record your requests and answers.
- Pray with others and encourage them to pray as well.



Checklist for Entry:

- Identify and research the community or people group you want to reach.
- Create a list of names of those where you live, work, and play that are far from God or you are not sure are following Jesus.
- Learn about their culture and needs by asking questions about food, family, friends, festivals or events they participate in, what they do for fun, and about their faith background.
- Pray for opportunities to share the gospel.
- Look for ways to serve and meet needs in the community. Be prepared to take action during these service opportunities to share your story and the gospel.






Checklist for Gospel:

- Prepare and practice sharing the gospel in a clear and concise way out loud with a believer friend. Practice using the 3 circles gospel tool.
- Look for opportunities to share the gospel with people you have built relationships with.

- Invite those that want to learn more but are not ready to follow Jesus to attend a discovery Bible study.



Checklist for Discipleship:

- Train existing believers and new believers in the 4-1-1 tool to take action in beginning to make disciples.
- Watch YouTube Training Video
- Use a simple discipleship process called the "3/3rds" format and the "Commands of Christ," to help them grow in their faith.
- Watch YouTube Training Video
- Encourage them to share what they are learning with others.
- Hold them accountable to apply what they are learning in their daily lives.





Checklist for Church Formation and Leadership Development:

- Find a practitioner coach who can model to and assist you in church formation.
- Develop a Four Fields plan to reach your City and multiply disciples, leaders, and churches.
- Ask your coach to assess your skills and give feedback on your vision and strategic plan.



Coaching Tip

Remember, each field is interconnected and is not necessarily sequential but in some ways does build on the previous one. It's important to be intentional and prayerful in each step and trust the Holy Spirit's leading.

At its core, coaching is about reinforcing and developing skills until the recipient has both confidence and competence in their abilities.


When you work with a coaching network, you'll receive training and support in taking action on the skills needed to multiply disciples, leaders, and churches.




